1. Introduction

The Quality Assurance Unit of the Athens University of Economics and Business conducted a survey to assess the quality of both the Academic Undergraduate Programmes and the services provided by the Athens University of Economics and Business. Participation in the survey was voluntary, the data requested for completion was collected anonymously, so that it was not possible to identify the participants.

Therefore, this report presents the results of the survey of graduates of the Undergraduate Programmes of Studies (BSc) of the Athens University of Economics and Business (AUEB), which was conducted from 2/04/2024 to 11/04/2024 for the needs of the AUEB Quality Assurance Unit's ESDP.

The evaluation was carried out using an electronic questionnaire (Limesurvey), which includes 24 closed-ended questions, grouped in 4 sections (Personal Information, Further Studies, Work, University).

Graduates of the BScs, who have registered with the UBA Alumni, for the academic years 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 and 2023-24 participated in the survey. A total of 3,417 emails were sent to BSc alumni, of which 443 fully completed surveys were collected and 190 partially completed surveys were collected, which were not included in this survey.

The results, discussed in the following sections, are presented in bar graphs and tables.




Image 1: Bar chart for gender




Image 2: Bar chart for undergraduate programs




Image 3: Bar chart for the academic year of graduation




Image 4: Bar chart for staying in Greece




Image 5: Bar chart on whether you continued postgraduate studies




Image 6: Bar chart for reasons for non-continuation of studies




Image 7: Bar chart for how similar is the subject of the postgraduate and the undergraduate




Image 8: Bar chart for this period




Image 9: Bar chart for type of work




Image 10: Bar chart for the industry




Image 11: Bar chart for participation in the internship program




Image 12: Bar chart for cooperation proposals




Image 13: Bar chart for times you've changed jobs




Image 14: Bar chart for job satisfaction




Image 15: Bar chart for ways to find a job




Image 16: Bar chart for status within 6 months after graduation




Image 17: Bar chart for status within 12 months after graduation




Image 18: Bar chart for net salary after 12 months of work




Image 19: Bar chart for status within 24 months after graduation




Image 20: Bar chart for satisfaction with undergraduate course content




Image 21: Bar chart for teacher level satisfaction




Image 22: Bar chart for infrastructure satisfaction




Image 23: Bar chart for the suitability of the undergraduate curriculum in the labor market




Image 24: Bar chart to meet student needs
